Advisory Notification

Belmont Emergency Management would like to make you aware of the following advisory from The National Weather Service

The National Weather Service has issued a Cold Weather Advisory to remain in effect from 6pm on Saturday to 1pm on Sunday. Very cold wind chills as low as 20 below are expected.

- ***Bitterly cold temperatures and gusty winds will lead to dangerous wind chill temperatures. Exposure to these wind chills may result in hypothermia and frostbite. Exposed skin can become frostbitten in as little as 30 minutes under forecast conditions.***
- ***Cold temperatures may lead to frozen or burst pipes.***
- ***Improper use of heaters may result in fires or carbon monoxide poisoning.***
