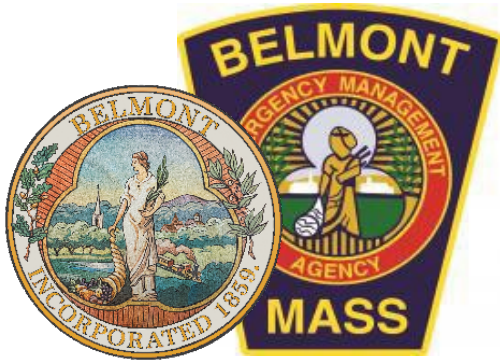




BELMONT EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Warning Notification

Belmont Emergency Management would like to make you aware of the following information from the Massachusetts Emergency Management Agency:

The National Weather Service and MEMA Agency Meteorologist are forecasting strong to damaging winds across the Commonwealth today along with periods of heavy rain and embedded thunderstorms. Southerly winds gusts of 45 to 60 mph tonight can be expected, with the strongest gusts up to 70 mph in eastern MA being possible between 10pm tonight and 4am tomorrow morning. Rain amounts of 1-3 inches with localized higher amounts may result in minor to moderate river flooding.

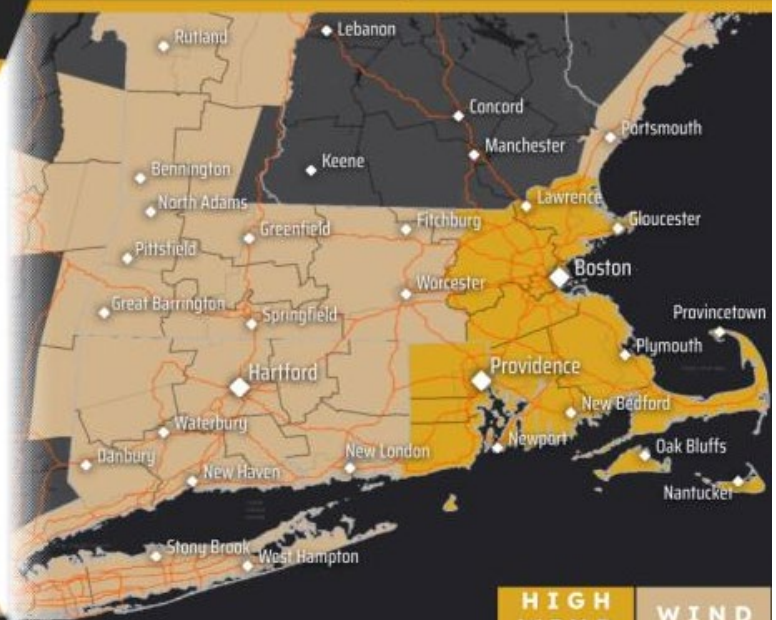
- Southerly Wind Gusts 45-65 MPH
